Introduction from the Headteacher

This Development Plan has been designed to be both flexible and robust and follows input from Governors and the Senior Leadership Team. It focuses on ensuring the school's mission, vision, and values remain central to everything we do, and that the educational opportunities our children and students receive, while at Beaulieu, provide them with a forward-thinking mindset.

Our statement of aims demonstrates how our mission, vision, and values will be embedded into all aspects of the school.

This plan covers the period from January 2025 to January 2030. This allows us to deliver in the short term while planning for the longer-term success of the school.

The purpose of the Development Plan is to give a clear statement of the direction in which the school is moving. It shows how we will develop the school around our core aims into the future, and allows us to include both aspirational and practical objectives.



Statement of aims

3. To inspire pupils in all aspects of their learning through specialist subject teaching, embracing innovative pedagogy, technology and IT.
4. To develop in each student a high degree of intellectual curiosity, beyond the expected levels of subject knowledge and high academic achievement, and to foster a life-long love of learning.
5. To provide outstanding personalised pastoral care with a strong sense of belonging to a safe, caring, inclusive and happy environment in which everyone feels valued, as befits the understanding of the dignity of the human person in the Catholic Christian foundation of the school.
6. To promote an interest in the arts, music, drama, dance, and public speaking and to encourage and challenge students through a stimulating co-curricular programme.
7. To promote the importance of physical wellbeing and team spirit through a culture of sport for all with a wide range of individual and team sports.
8. To promote the importance of being a responsible global citizen and to develop an awareness of, and to contribute to, both the local, national and international community, as well as a sense of connection to tradition and those who have gone before us.
9. To support all teaching and operations staff, particularly through their continuing professional development, enabling them to promote Beaulieu as a community of leaders and learners that contributes to the wider field of education.
10. To work in close partnership with parents, carers, and agencies to provide the very best opportunities and support for the students.
