Students benefit from our Forest School, which offers rich outdoor learning and exploration opportunities, as well as our modern

laboratory designed to support practical, high-engagement STEM education. For older students, our Sixth Form Centre and dedicated silent study areas provide a mature, focused environment that promotes independence and academic success.

Additionally, to ensure students benefit from the finest facilities the Island has to offer, they regularly leave the school to participate in high-quality learning and enrichment activities.

# How strong are the academics?

Our performance in public examinations at the end of Year 11 and Year 13 places us in the top 10% of schools in the UK, with some subjects ranking in the top 1%. The percentage of students achieving top grades places us among the best schools on the island, including those that are academically selective.

Students benefit from high-quality teaching, ambitious targets, and personalised support that stretches every individual. Our results, university destinations, and progression pathways show strong and improving outcomes. The idea that academically strong children need to look elsewhere no longer reflects the reality of our performance and provision.

Our records show that academically strong children excel here, and those who begin with lower attainment receive the personalised support and high expectations needed to achieve strong outcomes.
